SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

We believe that a school uniform is important:

- It looks smart
- Wears well
- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Gives a common purpose
- Fosters a feeling of pride

We ask that all children wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

Our school colours are navy blue and grey.

Our school uniform is as follows:

Navy blue school sweatshirts or cardigans with grey trousers or skirt.

For summer wear as above, or:

School polo shirt.

Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name.

For safety reasons we ask that the children do not wear jewellery in school. Small stud earrings are acceptable.

PE Kit

For health and safety reasons it is important that children are properly dressed for any physical activity.

Our uniform for PE is as follows:

Pumps, t-shirt and shorts. Children in KS2 will need games clothing and swimming kit.

PE kit should be kept in a named drawstring bag.

PE kit should be kept in school and returned home for washing at weekends and holidays. All items of PE clothing should be named.
