Dear parents/carers,

After our very successful Young Voices event at the Sheffield Arena on Monday, we have another concert to prepare!

The next Mrs Sunderland workshop is on Thursday 15th February 2018 at Huddersfield Town Hall. It is called "The Mighty Sky" by Beth Neilson Chapman and features songs old and new. We will be led by Thom Meredith and accompanied by the Musica Youth Symphony Orchestra and Chris Pulleyn on piano. There will be spectacular lighting effects, including lasers, by Harry Meredith. The workshop will be held in the morning, 9am-11.30am, and we will walk there and back, as normal, though we will have to leave school at 8.30am to ensure we get there for a 9am start. Parents and carers can attend the morning workshop and buy restricted view gallery seats for £3. Children go for free but still need a ticket and a seat for safety reasons.

To enable more parents and carers to watch the concert, it will also run in the evening, 7pm-8pm. You should bring your child to the Ramsden Street entrance between 6pm and 6.20pm, where a Mrs Sunderland steward will collect them and bring them to me in the Town Hall. After the concert, I will take all the children to the bottom of the library steps on the piazza so you can collect them. Tickets are available for this from the Kirklees Box Office via the library, by phone 01484 225755, online at www.kirkleestownhalls.co.uk or at the Town Hall door on Corporation Street. They cost £5 (or free for children) and will be in the area or balcony. We will be on the right hand side of the stage as you look at it, so choose your seats so you can see us!

Finally, we are one a very few schools who have been asked to sing 3 songs from The Mighty Sky songs at the final Mrs Sunderland Gala Concert on Saturday 24th February 2018. The concert starts at 7pm but we would need to rehearse 5.30pm-6pm. We could have a picnic tea at the Town Hall before the concert to fill the time! The songs would be at the end of the first half, when we could leave if we wish.

I'm sorry this is a lot to take in all at once! Please could you complete the attached letter and let me have it back as soon as possible? Thank you for your continued support.
