A message to all parents and carers from the Headteacher and Chair of Governors.

This is our home/school agreement. We believe that a close partnership between home and school is vital in helping children and young people to get the very best from their education.

Home/school agreements are part of every school's partnership with parents and children. This agreement allows all of us to make a clear commitment to working together.

The agreement makes clear what is expected, so that pupils will be able to work hard and be happy, safe and successful at school. We want you as parents to take an active part in your child's education at Moldgreen.

At this school we are determined to give every child a chance to do well. We look forward to a strong partnership with you.

THE SCHOOL WILL

- Provide a broad balanced curriculum, which meets all the National Curriculum requirements.
- Encourage children to do their best at all times.
- Encourage children to take care of their surroundings at school and in the community.
- Tell parents of their child's progress at regular meetings and send home an annual report.
- Contact parents if there are any ongoing problems or concerns.
- Keep parents informed about school activities.
- Ensure children are safe when using any form of electronic device.
- eSafety will be taught and closely monitored.
- Teach children how to stay safe in society and who to speak to.

THE FAMILY WILL

- Make sure that children arrive at school on time at 8.55 am and are collected at:
Rec and KS1—3.20pm
KS2—3.25pm
Nur—3.30pm
- Make sure that children attend school regularly and provide an explanation if they are absent.
- Attend Parents Evenings to discuss progress.
- Let school know about any concerns or problems that might affect a child's work or behaviour.
- Support children in all opportunities for home learning and encourage children to complete homework.
- Support the school policy on uniform and behaviour.
- Ensure all children are safe when using any form of electronic device.
- Support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately post comments or upload any images, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community or bring the school into disrepute.

THE CHILDREN WILL

- Try their best at all times.
- Be considerate and treat others, as they would wish to be treated.
- Always arrive on time and ready for school.
- Speak politely at all times and be prepared to listen and speak in turn.
- Remember that bullying and fighting is not acceptable.
- Remember that pupils have a right to learn and teachers have a right to teach.
- Follow their agreed class code, linked to UNCRC Rights of the Child.

HOME / SCHOOL CONTRACT

Within school, staff model the highest standards of behaviour, we expect the same from all parents and carers. Any inappropriate behaviour on school premises will not be tolerated and school will take legal action.
