Absence from school

Perfection	100%	0 days off school

Pease be aware that if your child is absent from school without it being authorised, you could be fined. Leave of absence can only be granted in exceptional circumstance.

An exceptional circumstance could be:-

A bereavement of a close family member.

A family needs to be together because of a serious and significant traumatic event.

Visiting seriously ill relative- end of life imminent.

A parent/carer is in the armed forces.

We will require evidence if you apply to request any absence to be authorised. Children having more than 5 days unauthorised leave of absence over the school year will also have their details passed on to Kirklees and this could result in a fine being issued.

Families taking children on unauthorised leave of absence year on year will lead to Kirklees Council taking the parents straight to prosecution which could lead to a criminal record and a fine up to £1,000.

WISE OWL CLUB



We are pleased to announce that our Wise Owl Breakfast Club and After School Club starts on Monday 10^{th} January. It is open to pupils aged 5-11 years old. The club will run from 7.45am-8.55am each morning for 20 prebooked places.

At the club, the children will be provided with a breakfast of cereal and bagels and the aim is to have an informal relaxed atmosphere with board games and various activities.

The cost of the food is subsidised by the National Breakfast Club and so the cost of attending the club is £3.50 per day. Unfortunately we do not accept any entries after 8.30am.

All sessions must be paid for before they enter Breakfast Club or After School Club.

Our Twilight Wise Owl Club runs from 3.05pm to 5.30pm daily. It is open to all pupils aged 5-11 years old. We will initially have 20 prebooked places every day. The children will have a light snack and juice during the session. Activities will be planned and organised for the children or support given with homework if pupils choose. The cost for the club is £7.00 per session, with a discounted rate of £6 for any siblings. Sessions must be booked and paid in advance.


