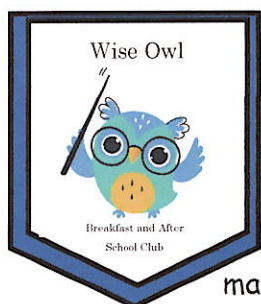
Reminders

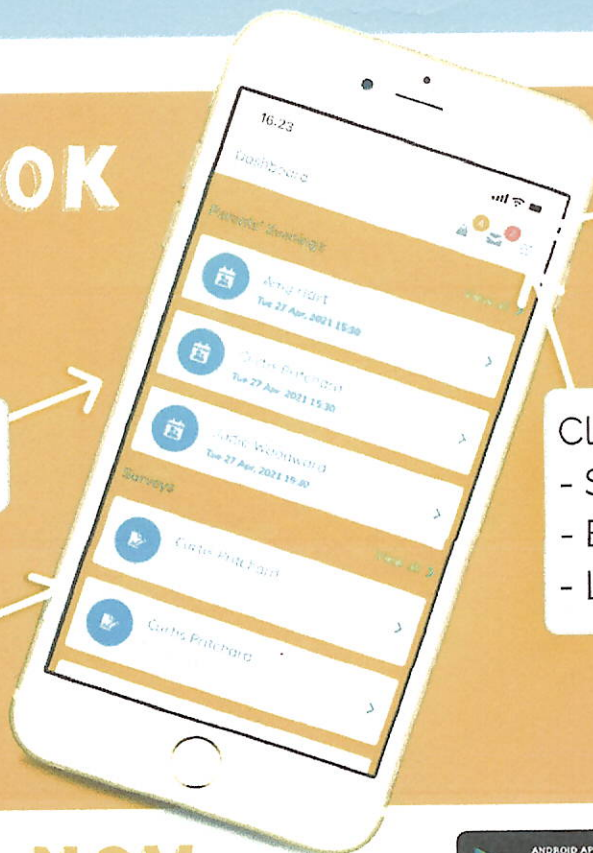
LOGGING IN
