Science Week In School



This week it has been Science week in our school. Each year group has been involved in different exciting science lessons.

Pre- school have been investigating colours using skittles.

Reception have been busy planting and have also had the excitement of having eggs in an incubator that have started to hatch chicks. They have been learning all about the life cycle of a chick.

Year 1 have been making slime. This is a non-reversible chemical change by combining glue, slime accelerator and bicarbonate of soda. They have observed how much it grew and then compared how far it stretches to an elastic band. Some children measured using a ruler how far their slime stretched.
