## Remote Learning Update

Can you help us, to help your child's learning? The teachers are planning work for your children to do, as required by The Department for Education. Most children are accessing their learning through our learning platforms of Tapestry (Early Years) and Purple Mash.

The platforms allow teachers to feedback to the children, so they know how to improve their work. Where work packs are required by children with limited computer access, the school asks that the parents collect them. The task of delivering over 100 packs is not sustainable.

**Please could you return the previous pack to school and collect the new one at the same time.** A paper pack should be only requested where the children cannot access the online learning platform. **Only in exceptional circumstances will the pack be delivered.** Please also note that teachers will contact you from unknown numbers to check you are ok with remote learning. If we don't hear from you then Mrs Sweczyk or Mrs Pearson will try to contact you. We may carry out home door-step visits if we cannot contact you.

Please contact the class teacher if you need support with the remote learning. We understand you are not teachers and many parents are trying to juggle work commitments with home schooling.

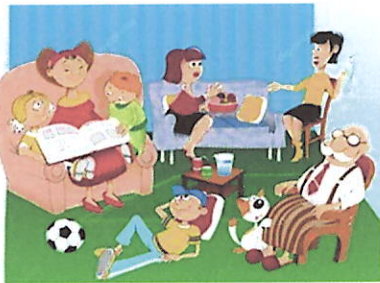
## Latest Covid-19 response update-Staff testing

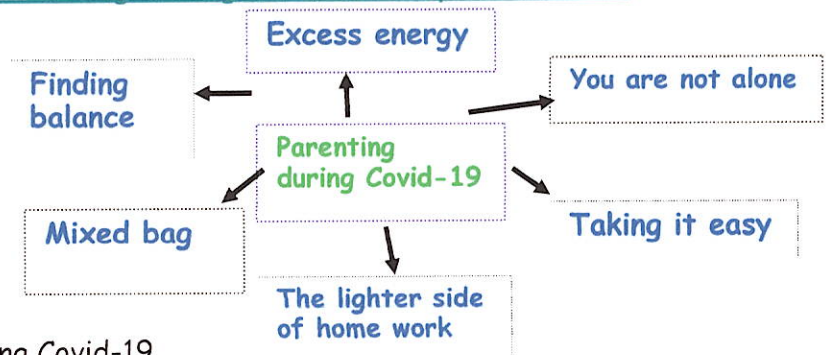


## Positive parenting During covid-19
